You do not need to come to put in point. Your vehicle will pick you up at the finishing point about which our staff at booking counter shall let you know your driver where to meet you.

JK Tourism Safty Guidelines

- No body is allowed to take the raft trip with out a helmet and life jacket and a raft guide and assistant raft guide.
- Pregnant women, asthmatics patient, people having cardiac problems.
- Physical and mentally challenged people are advised not to take the trip
- women in saries and doties are not allowed to take the trip unless they change into acceptable wear.
- Cell phone, wallets, Cameras and any form of valuable should not be taken on the raft.
- Children below 12 years are on allowed to take the trip by the order of tourism department
